Once a student has completed his course of study, he will be fully prepared to have a career as a Vedic pandit. This will allow him to support his family and most importantly, preserve and promote Vedic yagyas and the knowledge contained in the Vedas throughout the world.

- 1.) Helping charity bestows good karma upon the donor.
